

**150 Club Board Meeting  
January 2, 2023**

The meeting was called to order at 9 a.m. by President Denny Spencer.

**Minutes** from the December 2022 Board Meeting were approved as posted.

Terri Clark, **Treasurer**, gave the treasurer's report. After much discussion and the solvency of the Club finances, Patti Barnhart moved and Mary Jacobs seconded that we use club finances for the January Pizza Event. The motion passed. There will be no charge to members. The Board authorized an increase in the Tournament budget to \$500.

**Membership** – Bonnie reported that we currently have 92 paid members with 4-6 more who will be recorded later. Denny gave numbers to the board: 2021 – 261 members with 210 playing; 2022—311 members with 163 playing. He is concerned that the 150 Golf Club may lose its Charter Club status. When the club was formed years ago, there were over 300 members. We are now scrambling to get 100 members to maintain our Charter Club status – a drop of 30%. Other Board members expressed their concerns with the lower numbers and with the fact the lower membership is probably due to alternating tee times with shotgun starts.

**Pairings** – Chris needs the schedule for play dates for February and March. Denny will check and send that information to Chris to post on the web site. There is still some confusion with when to sign up (Monday before noon). And some people are not able to sign up because their name doesn't come up as available and they are current active members.

**Publicity** – We have a ¼ page ad in this month's Grand Times. Pat Dirschberger put up some additional signs around SCG to help advertise the 150 Golf Club.

**Sunshine** – Nancy sent a card to Gail Manning on the death of her husband. Terri Clark gave her another name of another couple who just needs a "thinking of you" because of ailing family member.

Mary Jacobs moved, Bonnie Manning seconded the motion to sponsor 2 holes at the Ladies Grand Niners Tournament the beginning of March. We sponsored 1 hole last year. Received positive input from that sponsorship.

Mary Jacobs is head of the nominating committee. She is planning to put a sign in the 150 Golf Club window outside the entrance to Cimarron Pro Shop listing the officers and the directors. She is hoping that more people will step up to take over/volunteer for several of these positions.

Judy will prepare a document to be emailed to all members containing important information discussed during the board meeting.

There being no further business, meeting was adjourned at 10 a.m.
