

## FEBRUARY 2021 NEWSLETTER

**IMPORTANT:** Because of COVID, signing up at the last minute is not flexible!! Remember that members need to sign up to **play before the Wednesday noon deadline**. The pairings with tee times have to be turned into the Pro Shop by Wednesday afternoon. Sign up is open late Wednesday; so do it on that day. Should you have problems getting signed up, please call Chris Gaare at 503-980-8757. She can walk you through the process and instructions are on the Web site.

If you forget to sign up before Wednesday noon, **call the appropriate Pro Shop**, not the pairings chair, to see if there are times left for 150 Golf Club members. **If you need to cancel, call the Pro Shop!**

**We need your help:** We need at least 3 people to serve on the Nominating Committee, whether you are a new member or a seasoned member. **March is election month**. The positions in the 150 Golf Club are President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer; Committee Directors are Membership, Pairings, Publicity, Social and Web Master. **The 150 Golf Club depends upon volunteers**. Let the Board know if you would like to help by taking on one of these positions. Descriptions for each position are on the Web site under **General Information – Club Officers**. We need back-up people for Membership, Pairings, and Web Master.

Since we are doing tee times, **you take a maximum of 6 strokes per hole**. This means after hitting the ball 5 times, pick up your golf ball and record a 6 for that hole. Please pick up your golf ball after 5 strokes to help keep pace of play.

**Guest Policy:** A person or persons may play a maximum of 3 times. After the third play date, the person or persons needs/need to join the 150 Golf Club. According to CAM, they are unable to play again without joining the Charter Club.

**New Members/Lost Name Tag:** *If you haven't picked up your name tag, they are on a magnetic board in the left drawer between the Cimarron Pro Shop and the outside patio. Help yourself! Tags are ordered in batches rather than one at a time.*
