

League Information

League Play:

Winter – (Following annual autumn overseeding) Sundays.

Depending on the week, we either play with a shotgun start at 12:30PM or assigned tee times starting at 12:00PM.

Summer – Sunday with tee times starting at 6:00AM to 7:00AM

Sign-Up:

Winter – Use the online Sign-Up beginning at 12:30PM Monday, 10 days before the Sunday of play and ends at 12:00PM on the Monday preceding play.

Summer – Call the Cimarron pro-shop. Sign-up Begins on Monday and ends Saturday at noon.

Cancellations:

If you need to cancel, the way to do it will vary based on the day you are canceling. Shotgun days – email the Pairings Chair; tee time days – call the pro shop.

Step by step Instructions for cancelling can be found in the Online Help selection. Click the HELP button to take you there.

No-shows will be fined \$5.00. In cases of emergency, waiver of fines will be reviewed by the fine committee. Fines must be paid within 15 days, or the member will not be allowed to play until the fine is paid.

Check in:

- On Shotgun days, check in with the 150 Golf Club registration table between 11:30 AM and 12:00 PM. You will receive your pairings assignment, a ticket for free range balls and the score card. (The captain (first person on the card) has the responsibility to maintain the scorecard and attest to its accuracy at the end of the round. The captain shall also make certain that the scorecard is deposited into the appropriate receptacle.)

- Check in at the pro shop to pay for your round. Note that each player must present their CAM Identification Card at time of payment. If necessary, rent a golf cart. (It is advisable to check with your foursome on cart availability before renting one.)

- Once you have checked in for shot gun, know which hole you are starting on and go to that designated parking spot in the cart parking area adjacent to the practice range. Here you can meet the others that you will be playing with. At this time you need to make necessary cart arrangements. If you do not have your own cart you may need to rent one.

On Tee Time days, check in with the pro shop 20 minutes to a half hour and follow pro shop announcements. The score card will be with the starter. Pay your greens fees, receive your free range balls. Be sure to put the completed card in the 150 Golf Club box by the entrance to the Cimarron Pro Shop.

Warm-up:

- A limited number of warm-up balls are provided free of charge for 150 Golf Club members prior to the start of the round for use on the driving range. To receive your voucher for the practice balls, you must check in prior to 12:00PM on shotgun days or a half hour before your tee time.

- You may also use the putting green, or chipping area.

Weekly Meeting:

- When we have shot gun play, a short meeting is held 15 minutes prior to the start of the round. A club officer usually updates the membership on club news, special events and the play of the day. A club pro often updates us on course conditions, provides rules reminders. and conducts a short clinic.
