

**150 Golf Club Board Meeting**  
**May 2, 2022**  
**Phoenix Room, Palm Center**

Members present: Denny S., Terri C., Chris, G., John B., Patti B., Pat D., Nancy J., Mary J., Bonnie M., Judy C.

Meeting called to order at 8:50 a.m. by President Denny Spencer.

**Secretary** – Minutes approved as sent out and posted on the web site.

**Treasurer** -- Terri Clark reported that the club is doing well. We were able to pay for most of the Social functions this year. Next year, we may need to charge a minimum fee of \$5 for 3 of the five and \$10 for the Annual Meeting. Name tags are now \$8 each. Can Do Engraving has been sold and is under new management.

The Board decided to start charging a no-show fee of \$5 for members who don't call the pro shop to cancel during the regular season (November through April) at least 24 hours in advance. Chris brought up that if we have Shotgun Starts, members should call her so she can rearrange the cards.

**Sunshine** – Nancy Johnson has mailed a card to Maggie Anderson. If you hear of any other people needing a note of encouragement, thinking of you, or sympathy, be sure to let Nancy know.

**Pairings** – Chris confirmed with Denny that during the regular season, every other week will be shotgun start (ss) and the other tee times (tt). She has been leaving a copy of the pairing requests with the table at SS so that people who want to play together stay together. She would prefer, whenever possible, that people call her prior to Sunday if they need to cancel and/or add on Shotgun Start days. Tee Times, members need to let the pro shop know that they are not coming or that they want to play.

Denny brought up that we will need to **change our sign-up timing beginning after overseeding (probably November)**. The club house needs the number of people playing on the following Sunday by Monday noon. Hence, **signup will close Sunday evening at 6 p.m.** The cards won't be printed until later in the week as there are cancellations and/or add-ons.

**Clarification:** Pairings are done November through May 31. Summer hours are June, July, August until overseeding. Members call the pro shop to sign up. Tee times on Sundays between 6 and 7 a.m. are reserved for 150 Golf Club.

**Membership** – Bonnie reported we currently have 167 members. We will keep the membership dues at \$30. She will update the current letter that goes out to all new members. The policy for no-show fees will be included in the letter. **Mary Jacobs** volunteered to call those who do not cancel. When people sign up during the summer or in September, October, November, their \$30 membership fee covers through the following year.

**Social** – Pat Dirschberger reported that we had a good turnout for the hot dog social. We tipped the personnel for their help. The Board agreed that tips should be included for those personnel who do help serve at the various socials.

Pat has updated the Social Binder and has it ready for Patti Barnhart. The Board would like to have additional gifts, gift cards, as well as cards to SCG pro shops. These were well received by members. One suggestion was to increase the SCG pro shop cards to \$20, even though that would mean fewer cards.

Next season's date were discussed as President Denny has to turn in our request for rooms now. They will be confirmed some time in September. Dates may change to coordinate with shotgun starts.

- **Tentative Dates for Next Season:**

- **November 20** – Snack Day; “opening/welcoming” time. This may change to November 13, depending upon the overseeding scheduled. No charge to members.
- **January 15** – Pizza; charge members \$5
- **February 12** – Subway Sandwiches; charge members \$5
- **March 12** – Annual Meeting/Election of Officers; catered; charge members \$10
- **April 16** – Hot Dot Day; charge members \$5

**Tournament** – Everyone enjoyed John's fun, over-sized “holes” for the day. Board suggested that John work on “simple” tournaments for each of the social event dates. Denny offered his Excel worksheet to help with “pairing” people with like scores on these special days.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

Judy will put out a newsletter for May, and probably an eblast to cover signup for the summer “hours” as well as any other information the Board would like put out to the membership.

New table decorations are needed. We want to keep them simple but nice. We usually have 10 tables with 8 people at each. Patti and her committee will work on these.

We have \$500 from the Pro Shop to spend on gift cards. We agreed to allocate \$1000 for all 5 social events. The Social Committee (Patti Barnhart) can decide how much to spend at each event.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10 a.m.
